
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Di-#-acetato-1: $2\kappa^2 O:O'$;2: $3\kappa^3 O:O,O'$ -bis(5,5,7,12,12,14-hexamethyl-1,4,8,11-tetraazacyclotetradecane)- $1\kappa^4 N, 3\kappa^4 N$ -bis(perchlorato- $2\kappa^2 O,O'$)-2-sodium-1,3-dizinc perchlorate

Abstract: In the title salt, $[NaZn_2(CH_3COO)_2(CIO_4)_2(C_{16}H_{36}N_4)_2]CIO_4$, the macrocyclic ligand binds to the Zn²⁺ cations through their four amino N atoms; the Zn²⁺ cations are also each covalently bonded to an acetate ion. For one zinc atom, the acetate group is monodentate, and the geometry is a distorted ZnN₄O trigonal bipyramid; for the other, the acetate group is anisobidentate and the geometry is a distorted ZnN₄O₂ octahedron. The two macrocycle-zinc acetate units are bridged through a diperchloratosodium unit. In the crystal, the complex cations and uncoordinated perchlorate anions are linked by N-H_{**}O hydrogen bonds.
